
THE AUTHOR

# A PERFECTLY HARMONIOUS WHOLE OUT OF THOUSANDS OF DETAILS

The cutter's handicraft on these bowls is comparable to the work of a mosaic master, always looking for just the right shape of stone to fit the composition of the work. These cuts are also completed "alla prima", meaning that the glass is cut directly without pre-sketching. The outcome depends on the trained eye and sense of proportion of the master cutter, who combines thousands of details into a single harmonious whole.



### IN THE REALM OF EVERLASTING ICE

The vivid colours typical of Moser art pieces – aquamarine, beryl and crystal – evoke water. The water-like effect is further enhanced by small flat facets dotting the surface of the bowl to create the impression of ice floes. Gazing into the bowl's depths makes one feel as if time has frozen for an instant and the surrounding world has been plunged into silence.
